Camping: Rules & Regulation

- Campsites are limited to 6 people per site.
- There are no TICKET or CAMPING refunds or exchanges.
- 24 Hour SECURITY is provided by the Carolina Entertainment Complex for your safety.
- Campers under 18 yrs. of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- **MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EJECT ANYONE AT ANY TIME AT ITS SOLE DISCRETION. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR ANY EJECTION.**
- No electric is available at this time.

- **Campfires:**
- All state statues and local ordinances concerning open fires will apply.
- Every fire must be a contained fire. This means on legs, above ground with covers on top and bottom and a screen around the center.
- All fires must be out completely by **2:30 am**. Citations will be issued to anyone in violation

- **Check-in:**
- Campers may arrive on Friday, November 21, 2008 at **1:00pm**, and must vacate the grounds by Sun., November 23, 2008 at **11:00am**.
- Check-in times are from **9:00am to 8:00pm**
- As you enter please go to the campers' check-in to pick up your window sticker which must be attached to your vehicles windshield at all times.
- Upon check-in your camping ticket will be exchanged for wristbands. **NO ONE** will be allowed in the gate without it. **NOTE: WRITSTBANDS WILL NOT BE REPLACED!**
- Every camper must have a Carolina Entertainment Complex Camper Application Copy and exchange it for a wristband at main entrance.

- **Showers:**
- Showers are available from approximately **6:00am to 6:00pm** daily at a normal charge

- **Vehicles Per Site:**
- One steering wheel per site is included in your camping fee.
- **ALL ADITONAL VEHICLES WILL BE CHARGED \$25.00.**
- Extra vehicles may be placed on your site provided, if they fit completely on your site, if not, extra vehicles may be placed in camp overflow parking. (Either location is same cost.)

- **Behavior:**
- Excessive rowdiness and underage drinking will not be tolerated.
- Disruptive or disorderly behavior will result in arrest and/or ejection from the campground and festival site.

- **Generators:**
- All generators must have a good muffler system and be turned off at **2:30am**.

- **Clean up:**
- Please leave your campsite clean!! Campers can place their trash at curbside for daily pickup. Please bring your own trash bags.
- Campsites will be inspected following the festival.
- Cites not cleaned up will be charged **\$50.00** clean up fee.

- **Sanitary:**
- Barnhill Septic Service is on site during the festival offering pumping service for you RV or camper. To arrange pumping call: **843.431.8643**.
- As stated in Marion County Health Code, **NO DUMPING GREY WATER IS PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES!!**
- **VIOLATORS WILL BE EJECTED AND CITATIONS WILL BE ISSUED. THIS IS STRICTLY ENFORCED!!**

- **Solicitation:**
- No advertising or solicitation of any kind!! This includes signs, banners, and flags with the exception of the Marion County Private School or sponsors (**NO OFFENSIVE SIGNS OR BANNERS**) **CAROLINA ENTERTAINMENT COMPLEX**.
- Under no circumstances will any camper be permitted to engage in any private business.
- No sale of food, beverages, merchandise or any other goods/services.
 1. Food and beverage cannot be carried onto the concert site.
 2. Marion Country School of Music – Marion County Private School is not responsible for theft, loss or damage to persons or property.
 3. No kegs or glass beverage containers allowed.
 4. No pets.
 5. No weapons or fireworks.
 6. No scooters, carts or other motorized vehicles.
 7. No large sound systems or DJ set-ups. (Small boom boxes only!)
 8. All vehicles leaving the grounds are subject to vehicle search upon re-entering.

We want your festival experience to be both safe and memorable! Marion County School of Music management and the Marion County Sheriffs Office have not found it necessary to issue the following rules to help ensure your safety:

- A. Cruising the campgrounds or festival site or driving from site to site will not be permitted. This includes all vehicles. **STICTLY ENFORCED!** Vehicles will only be permitted to operate on the site for the purpose of leaving or returning to a campsite from an off-site destination.
- B. All State traffic statues relating to the safe operation of motor vehicles will be **STICTLY ENFORCED**, including driving while intoxicated, reckless driving, and speeding. Passengers will not be permitted to ride in the cargo bed of trucks, sit or stand on rails or tailgates of trucks, or ride on the outside of any motor vehicle. **ALL VIOLATIONS OF STATE TRAFFIC STATUES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!!**
- C. **VIOLATIONS OF FESTIVAL RULES AND/OR STATE TRAFFIC STATUES MAY RESULT IN ANY OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**
- Citations and/or arrest by a law enforcement officer.
 - Temporary or permanent ejections of the vehicle from the festival site.
 - Temporary or permanent ejections of the responsible person or campsite.
